2005 A by Acacia Pinot Noir, California – Regularly \$15.99

The fruit for the A by Acacia Pinot Noir was harvested at night and in the early morning to protect the aroma and flavors of the grapes. After being received at the winery, they were whole-cluster pressed and then aged in a variety of oak resulting in a nice complexity. This wine offers aromas of violets, spice and black cherry with hints of vanilla. The medium-bodied palate includes rich flavors of plum, black cherry, and spice. The wine finishes with fine tannins and a hint of oak. Pair with cedar-planked salmon, roasted chicken or wild mushroom risotto.

2004 Tomaiolo Chianti Classico Riserva, Italy – Regularly \$11.99

Chianti is not a grape. It's a province in Tuscany in Central Italy. Chianti is primarily made from the Sangiovese grape. (The roots of the word "Sangiovese" mean "blood of Jupiter") The Chianti region has been producing this wine for over 700 years and is known as a classic "food" wine. This traditional wine is full-bodied and fruity with a bit of violet fragrance. The touch of cherries and pepper makes it perfect for steak, roasts, and sausages.

2003 Peter Lehmann GSM, Australia – Regularly \$14.99

In 1979 Peter Lehmann established a consortium in the Barossa Valley and in 1982 the winery was formally named Peter Lehmann Wines. As well as purchasing grapes from approximately 185 local independent growers, Peter Lehmann Wines sources a small percent from their own vineyards. The majority of vineyards where they source their fruit are classified as mature, ranging in ages from 20 to over 100 years old. This wine is a blend of 34% Grenache, 33% Shiraz, and 33% Mourvèdre: Grenache provides softness and palate sweetness; Shiraz brings opulence, richness and chocolate characters; Mourvèdre delivers an attractive peppery wildness. Try with lamb, pork, and veal.

2006 Red Knot Cabernet Sauvignon, Australia – Regularly \$12.99

Brothers Kym and John Davey planted this family-owned estate vineyard on land their grandfather purchased in 1959 in the McLaren Vale Wine Region of Southern Australia. Grapes for this wine are sourced from the Davey Family Vineyard and McLaren Vale Friends & Neighbors' Vineyards and are a blend of 86% Cabernet Sauvignon and 14% Shiraz. This medium-bodied Cabernet Sauvignon is filled with flavors of ripe blackberry, dark cherry and a hint of roasted coffee bean. The long, fruit finish is balanced with firm tannins, resulting in a structured and complex wine. **88 points – Robert Parker**
