2006 Markham Vineyards Sauvignon Blanc, Napa Valley - Regularly \$14.99

In 1972, Bruce Markham arrived in Napa Valley with the dream of starting a winery. Intent on crafting world-class wines for years to come, he purchased the "little jewels" that are still the Markham vineyards today. He was a pioneer in what is now the very heart of Napa, buying premium vineyard land before many understood the tremendous potential the valley offered for producing fine wines. Markham Winery has the distinction of being the fourth oldest continuously operated winery in Napa County.

"The '06 Markham Sauvignon Blanc has bright citrus flavors--tangerine, Meyer lemon and lime--that are effusive and fruity, with a hint of rose water and juicy acidity." - 87 points Wine Spectator

2006 Bianchi Signature Edna Valley Chardonnay, Paso Robles - Regularly \$17.99

Do you love a buttery, rich, balanced Chardonnay? Well, if you do then this is your wine! The grapes are sourced from the Edna Valley Vineyard which has one of the longest growing seasons in California due to its close proximity to the ocean. This vineyard site is owned by the Chalone Wine Group and the Niven family and for many years has been a laboratory for Burgundian and Rhone varietals. Several different clones of Chardonnay, Pinot Noir, and Syrah are planted throughout the vineyard. The Bianchi Chardonnay has floral aromas of citrus, pineapple, and kiwi, followed by a creamy, toasty finish. Only 62% is oak barrel fermented and sur-lie aged for six months creating a superbly balanced and intensely flavored wine. Glenn and his father purchased a winery and vineyard on the banks of the San Joaquin River in the Central Valley of California in 1974. It didn't take them long to start producing award winning wines. But Glenn wanted to do more, so in January of 2000 they purchased 40 acres of vineyards on the East side of Paso Robles and built a showcase winery and spectacular hospitality center. Now, they produce both their Heritage Collection, which are estate-grown, and the Signature Collection, which comes from an array of renowned vineyards throughout California's Central Coast.

2006 Red Knot Shiraz, Australia - Regularly \$12.99

John Davey, a veteran Australian winemaker, has worked throughout the Barossa Valley, Langhorne Creek and Yarra Valley as well as the McLaren Vale since the early 1990s. He and his brother Kym co-manage the family's Davey Family Vineyard which is the source of most of the fruit for this wine. They also purchase grapes from their neighbors' vineyards. With a blend of 97% Shiraz and 3% Grenache this "**Best Buy**" is bursting with mocha and ripe berry flavors. Red Knot Shiraz is not only great to drink with meat, especially duck, but also your favorite chocolate dessert.

2005 Liberty School Cabernet Sauvignon, Paso Robles - Regularly \$16.99

Liberty School is a family-owned winery in Paso Robles, the heart of California's Central Coast. The Hope family planted wine grapes here in 1978. This unique growing region is characterized by a diversity of vineyard soils, its proximity to the coast, and a climate of temperature shifts of up to 50 degrees. For over three decades, Liberty School has been among the best values in California wine. The Cabernet Sauvignon comes primarily from the east side of Paso Robles, prime Cabernet country, with the added complexity of a few west side sources. With very generous aromas of ripe raspberries and chocolate and soft flavors of black currant and cherry, this wine is ready to drink!
