



2007 De Loach Pinot Noir, California - Regularly \$13.99

At DeLoach Vineyards their passion is Pinot Noir! Their new winemaker Greg La Follette was the winemaker and general manager at Flowers on the Sonoma coast, and launched one of the most successful small Pinot labels to date. He was also named "**One of the 5 finest producers of Pinot noir by Robert Parker's Wine Advocate.**"

Deep ruby in color this Pinot Noir exhibits cherry, mint, leather and eucalyptus characteristics on the nose. The palate is big, round and supple with prominent cherry and cranberry fruit flavors complemented by notes of smoke and black pepper. The finish is long and lingering with soft tannins and attractive undertones of vanilla and toast. Enjoy this balanced wine with food or as an aperitif.--

2005 Francis Coppola Syrah Diamond Series - Regularly \$14.99

The Francis Coppola Diamond Series of wines are made from grapes grown in the cool valleys along California's rugged coast. Rich and ripe, these wines represent the individual flavors of the varieties accentuated by twelve months of barrel aging. The majority of vineyards for this Syrah are located in the central coast area of Paso Robles. The wine is rich and juicy, bursting with ripe summer fruit flavors and great concentration and depth. Enjoy with grilled meats and vegetables, enchiladas with red sauce, or a BLT!

2004 Pendulum Red Table Wine, Washington - Regularly \$26.99

The Columbia Valley's reputation for red wine is built on its ability to produce supple fruit, such as the Merlot, Cabernet, Syrah and other varieties that make up Pendulum. Sheltered from Seattle's maritime climate by the towering Cascade Mountain Range, the appellation receives less than 8 inches of rainfall annually. Long, warm summer days and significantly cooler nights produce fully mature fruit with concentrated flavors. Ripe blackberry, plum flavors and a hint of black licorice are balanced with a finish of toffee and toasty oak.

2006 Excelsior Cabernet Sauvignon, South Africa - Regularly \$9.99

Excelsior Estate has been owned by the de Wet family since 1870. The current owners are Freddie de Wet and his son Peter de Wet. Over the years the estate has been known for producing thoroughbred racehorses, and in the fifteen years between 1980 and 1995, Excelsior bred eight individual Classic winners. In 1981, a modern winery was constructed and today eighty percent of Excelsior is planted with vines. With the use of drip irrigation, canopy management and harvesting at optimum ripeness, Excelsior Cabernet Sauvignon is the top selling South African Cabernet Sauvignon in the USA. The wine has sweet fruit flavors, good structure, soft ripe tannins and a soft, clean finish.
